14/02817/out 12 new dwellings

Land off Long Street Road; The Parish Council objects to this application due to the site being outside the agreed development areas within the parish, against the residents opinions as per the 'Parish Plan', against the selected village criteria and would create unacceptable levels of additional congestion and traffic in an area already suffering from severe delays.

14/02802/ful 1 new dwelling

Coleraine, Forest Road; The Parish Council objects to this application due to the height and scale of the proposed property, over development of the site, concern regarding vision splay and the close proximity of the Forest Road/Hartwell Road junction.

15/00121/out 1 new dwelling

31 Tathall End; The Parish Council objects to this application as it not in keeping with the size of the hamlet and is outside the existing boundary of properties within Tathall End.

15/00073/ful Extension and alteration of public house plus 4 new dwellings

The Globe, Hartwell Road; The Parish Council objects to this application due to insufficient car parking space for public house customers, overcrowding by trying to fit too many houses in the space available and unsuitable positioning of houses where in effect they would be next to the car park and would share access with public house customers. The Parish Council is very keen to see the Globe reopen as a going concern but feels that the current plans are unacceptable.
